### **Open to full-time students:**

<u>Full time employees</u> of ITA motor carrier, private carrier, and associate member companies or <u>children or spouses</u> of full-time employees.

Scholarships are for degree or certification programs at college, community college, university, or vocational, business, or trade school.

### **ITLP Scholarship**

Two separate 1-year scholarships will be awarded to <a href="either a motor carrier member or associate member">either a motor carrier member or associate member</a> full-time student. 2 scholarship @ \$1,000 each.

This scholarship is administered by the Illinois Trucking Foundation on behalf of the Illinois Trucking Leadership Program and ITLP Alumni. The ITLP is an initiative aimed at growing the next generation of leaders in the trucking industry in Illinois. As part of their desire to serve the industry, ITLP Alumni initiated the creation of the ITLP Scholarship.

# Who is eligible to apply?

**Full-time employees** (*not contractors*) of a member company of Illinois Trucking Association, or that employee's children or spouse are eligible to apply.

The applicant may be a recent high school graduate, current college student, or "back to school" student. The student applicant must attend school on a full-time basis (minimum 12 credit hours per semester).

The qualifying employee must have worked full-time for the same ITA member company for at least one year.

- "Full-time" student means completing minimum of 12 credit hours per semester (not including summer school).
- Current (or continuing) student applicants must have at least a 2.5 GPA.
- "Employee" does <u>not</u> include independent contractors.
- Scholarships are for a degree or certificate program at a college, university, vocational, trade, or business school.
- <u>Submit only one application</u>. All 2023 scholarships will be awarded from the same pool of applicants.



## How are scholarships awarded?

All applications must be received no later than May 20, 2023. Scholarship winners will be recognized in the Illinois Trucking Association's magazine and weekly newsletter.

The applications will be "coded" so the committee will not know the name of the individual applicants, nor the sponsoring member company, during the review process.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the school and may be used for books, tuition, board, student fees.

<u>Submit only one application.</u> All 2023 scholarships will be awarded from the same pool of applicants.

# Where do I submit my application?

All <u>fully completed</u> applications (with required supplemental materials) must be mailed or e-mailed so they are <u>received no later than May 20, 2023</u>

- Full-time student (minimum 12 credit hours) beginning with next fall semester, and
- ITA member <u>full-time</u> employees (for minimum 1 year) or full-time employee's spouse, daughter, or son.

You will be disqualified if all these items below are not included. Check your work!

- 1. Write an essay (maximum 1 page, typed, no less than 10 pt. font), choosing only 1 of these 5 topics:
  - What is the greatest lesson in humility you have ever learned, and what did it teach you?
  - What do you feel is the greatest invention of your lifetime? How has this invention impacted your life and your future?
  - As celebrities seek publicity with shock value and sports figures seem to dominate the headlines, how would you encourage a younger child to identify with a role model? What characteristics should a good role model exemplify, and where should a child look to find such a role model?
  - Have you read a book that has significantly impacted or even changed the course of your life?
     Give a brief overview of the book and several examples of how the reading of this book impacted your life.
  - If you could change anything about the political system and elections in the USA, what would you change and why?
- Submit a signed letter of confirmation of eligibility from ITA member company owner or manager other than your parent or spouse. This letter should be on company letterhead and is required to verify student's eligibility to apply for scholarship. (See eligibility reminder above.).

- Letter (on company letterhead) from ITA
  member company owner or manager other
  than student's parent or spouse to verify
  student's eligibility to apply for scholarship.
  (Company must verify a full-time employee
  sponsor for a full-time student applicant)
- Transcript of grades (see page 2 of application).
- Typed essay (maximum one page, no smaller than 10 pt. font) on your choice of only 1 of these topics:
